1. General

This document provides additional information to the musical content (the *scores*) of the *#secretalbum - Baßtelstube* album project.

1.1. Relationship to other documents

This document relates to the statement of requirements (*SOR*) and the *score* documents. The relationship between the *SOR*, Music Description and Score versions is defined in the *SOR*.

1.2. Format of track descriptions

The track description specify the following:

1.2.1. Instrumentation

For each part (from top to bottom in the score), an instrument type and a potential alternative is given. From a requirements standpoint, the first choice is the “should” requirement, using either one has binding “shall” character.

Instruments are assumed to have a standard, fourth tuning, more specifically:

4-string: E-A-D-G

5-string: B-E-A-D-G

5/6-string: 6-string, or 5-string E-A-D-G-C

6-string: B-E-A-D-G-C

Acoustic bass guitars and double bass are 4-string, E-A-D-G

Instrument choices may require a 24-fret instrument. Consult the specified tonal range for your instrument choice.

Range is given as concert pitch, i.e. one octave lower than notated (e.g. E string is E1, not E2).

The range specifications are incomplete and for reference only. In case of doubt, the score shall take precedence.

1.2.2. Tempo and Meter

The “Musical Tempo” and “Meter” specifications are for reference only and copy the information from the score. In case of doubt, the score shall take precedence

The BPM specifications shall be treated as follows:

	If the track is a solo track, or all parts are recorded by multiple performers together, the BPM specification is for reference only. The musical tempo from the score shall be treated as the tempo specification.
	If the track is not a solo track and the involved performers agree on a way to handle tempo “that works”, the musical tempo from the score shall be treated as the tempo specification.
	Otherwise, the BPM specification shall be treated as the tempo specification. The musical tempo is for reference/guidance only.

1.3. Guidelines on Notation

	Square note heads shall be played as harmonics.
	Grace notes are notated as smaller notes which “do not count towards the meter”.
	Grace notes shall be interpreted as ornaments (e.g. acciaccatura)
	Ghost notes are notated as smaller notes which “do count towards the meter”.
	Ghost notes shall be interpreted as very quiet, short notes.
